The Keizer Fire District is establishing a Civil Service entrance register for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic with plans to fill one vacant position by March 1, 2016 and potentially others during the life of the list. Some of these positions may be SAFER Grant funded. Individuals filling this position are responsible for providing advanced life support care and transport of sick and injured persons, fire suppression, rescue, public service requests, public education, station/equipment maintenance and other related tasks. Minimum qualifications to apply are; valid and insurable Oregon Class "C" driver's license, State of Oregon Licensed Paramedic, NFPA Firefighter 1, NFPA Driver, and NFPA Hazardous Materials Operations level certifications. Within twelve months of employment must obtain NFPA Instructor 1 and reside within a 60-minute commuting distance from the District's main fire station. Paramedic program students will be allowed to apply upon receipt of verifiable proof of their program completion date being no later than June 30, 2016.

The above salary range includes a 10% paramedic pay incentive. The District currently offers the following benefits: sick time, vacation, holidays, health, vision, dental, disability, and life insurance, PERS retirement, medical savings plan, tax deferred medical and child care reimbursement plan, various deferred compensation plan options and education incentive.

All applications must be returned and/or postmarked by 5:00pm on Friday, December 11, 2015. Applications will NOT be accepted or considered if received/postmarked after this date.

After screening of the submitted applications, qualifying applicants will be invited to participate in a written examination scheduled for Monday, December 28, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. Applicants must also complete a National Testing Network FireTEAM examination and have those results submitted to the District by 5:00pm on December 28, 2015. Oral interviews of up to the top 20 candidates are scheduled for January 13 & 14, 2016.
