Emergency Services Consulting International (ESCI) is seeking a qualified Deputy Fire Marshal for the Keizer Fire District, to be hired in June, 2017. This position is being filled due to the retirement of the former Deputy Fire Marshal.

Organized in 1948, Keizer Fire District (KFD) provides Fire Protection, Fire Prevention services, Public Safety Education, and Community Emergency Medical Services to approximately 10 square miles, which includes the City of Keizer, and serves a resident population of approximately 39,000. KFD emergency responders responded to 4,685 calls for help in 2016, responding from one centrally located Fire Station with 32 career employees, 15 Volunteer Firefighters, and the 6 Explorer Scouts.

The ideal candidate will have a high level of experience, education, and current Fire Prevention & Code Enforcement certifications, as stipulated in the Deputy Fire Marshal Job Description. The minimum qualifications include International Code Council (ICC) Fire Inspector I or National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Inspector I, and NFPA Firefighter I. NFPA Fire Instructor I within one year, and ICC Fire Plans Examiner within one year. The person in this position, experiences a high degree of public interaction, therefore must have excellent skills in the area of interpersonal relations.

This is a Captain ranked position; who will report directly to the Fire Chief. It is essential that they be a self-starter and be able to work independently. The Fire District is experiencing substantial growth in both commercial and residential development. The Deputy Fire Marshal works closely with the City of Keizer's Department of Community Development, Marion County Building officials, and the City of Keizer, Code Enforcement Officer.

The Deputy Fire Marshal supervises a Public Education Specialist and may also supervise others as assigned. The position is represented by the International Association of Firefighters (IAFF) Local 3881.

This is an excellent opportunity with a quality organization that is very involved, well respected, and supported, by the community they serve.
