The Keizer Fire District is establishing a Civil Service entrance register for the positions of Single Role Paramedic.

Single Role Paramedic Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Associate Degree in Paramedicine or enrolled in a paramedic program
- Valid Oregon Driver license, or out of state license with ability to obtain a valid Oregon driver license within 90 days
- Oregon Paramedic License, or ability to obtain reciprocity within 90 days of hire
- NFPA Fire Apparatus Driver, EVOC or equivalent.

Paramedic program students will be allowed to apply upon receipt of verifiable proof that they are enrolled in a paramedic program. Candidate must be a licensed Paramedic by the time of hire.

The District currently offers the following benefits: sick time, vacation, holidays, health, vision, dental, disability, and life insurance, PERS retirement, medical savings plan, tax deferred medical and child care reimbursement plan, various deferred compensation plan options and education incentives.

The application process is an “open” process and applications will be accepted on an on-going basis. Interviews will be scheduled on an as needed basis.

When needed, candidates will be invited to a three-person engine company interview and will take a 50 question EMS written test. Scores will be tabulated and successful candidates will be invited to a Chiefs interview.
